Target Population	Women, ages 15 to 24
Intervention Setting	Clinics, dedicated sites, and through outreach or other services. Chlamydia testing can be implemented at any location where confidentiality of clients can be assured (e.g., private area or room) and where a specimen can be collected according to minimal standards as outlined by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration.
Key Measures	Self-assessment / Evaluation Tool
Cost	Low
Time to Implement	Patient/Client: one 20 minute session about testing in 1 of 3 ways: 1) Individual face-to-face sessions; 2) Small or large group sessions and 3) brochures, handouts, videos, or audiotape, or other non-personalized information deliver client-focus.
Difficulty to Implement <i>Resource Intensity</i>	Moderate
