I also wanted to inform you of some free apps that may assist staff with coding. One is ICD-10 Lite (free app). I have downloaded this to my iPad and it appears to be easy to use when you start with the search function. This is available for Android phones also (<https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.ipremiumapps.icd10cm.lite&hl=en>). Another app recommended by a coding manager I know is ICD-10 on the Go (<http://appshopper.com/medical/icd-10-on-the-go>). There is a small fee (\$2.99) for this app but I have not downloaded this one. You may want to “play” around with one of these apps and try to use it during ICD-10-CM training for local agency Implementation Team members that will be held in April/May, 2013.
