

#### AIM


Build and test a centralized mailed FIT outreach intervention to improve CRC screening and follow-up in community health center populations


#### **SCORE: Core Elements**

### **SCORE** Navigation

WhatProcess of identifying and addressing patient- and<br/>system-level barriers to follow-up colonoscopy

**Why** Enhance colonoscopy completion

How

Frequent and tailored contact with patients Collaboration with CHCs and GI clinics





# **SCORE Navigation: Calls**

**Introduction:** Navigator introduces program and addresses barriers **Prep check-in:** Ensure patient is aware of prep procedures (3 **Pre-procedure:** Ensure patient is ready for prep and procedure **Procedure follow-up:** Discuss results and answer any questions



# **SCORE Navigation: RCCHC**



# 15 eligible FIT+ patients

- 9 successful colonoscopies with navigation
- 5 lost to follow up or declined navigation
- 1 unsuccessful colonoscopy due to poor prep
- **3** patients used *go*SCORE (transportation program)
  - Building connections with GI facilities in eastern NC



# **SCORE** Navigation: **BRH**



3 eligible FIT+ patients

- 1 scheduled for colonoscopy
- 1 awaiting an appointment
- 1 unsuccessful colonoscopy due to poor prep; rescheduled



Leveraged local partnerships to link uninsured patients to quality care



## **SCORE** Navigation: BRH Colonoscopy Access

Commitment from DHP and Carolina Mountain Gastroenterology with instrumental support from Dr. Mike Newcomer and Kylee Diaz

- Providers donate time
- \$500 per patient covers facility, pathology, and anesthesia fees; additional \$125 consult fee as needed
- Funded by SCORE grant and UNC Lineberger Comprehensive Cancer Center









### **SCORE Navigation: Challenges**

- Covering colonoscopy prep and interpreting services for uninsured FIT+ patients
- Paying for colonoscopies for uninsured FIT+ patients in the east



### **Next Steps**

- Scale up implementation (expected start date: May 2020)
- Expand to outlying sites
- Spread to other CHCs



#### **Vision: Sustain and Scale**

A state-level program that supports CHCs across NC to deliver mailed FIT and navigation to follow-up colonoscopy
