Health departments that work jointly to conduct and submit a community health assessment (CHA) may choose to use the term “CHNA” rather than “CHA”. This review uses criteria set by the NC LHD Accreditation Board and adopted by NC DHHS. A CHNA is acceptable provided it meets these criteria.</p>
