### **NC Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (NC BRFSS)**

BRFSS is a random telephone survey of state residents that asks questions on health behaviors and preventive health practices.

Age Range: Adults 18+

### **Child Health Assessment and Monitoring Program (CHAMP)**

CHAMP measures health characteristics of children ages 0 through 17. Questions include health-related topics and provide data on the health issues of North Carolina children.

Age Range: Children under 18

### **NC Youth Risk Behavioral Surveillance System (YRBS)**

YRBS is a school-based survey of middle and high school students. Questions address health-risk behaviors such as alcohol and drug use, tobacco, sexual behaviors, diet, physical activity and injury and violence.
