



Does your child have health insurance?

Your child may qualify for healthcare coverage through North Carolina's **Medicaid** or **Health Choice (CHIP) grant program**—**free or low-cost health insurance** for children and teens*. Even children in a family of four with working parents earning \$52,968 a year or slightly more may qualify.

* NC's children in foster care on their 18th birthday may have Medicaid coverage until age 26.

*Children may receive Medicaid at 19-20 years of age but income limits are different.
